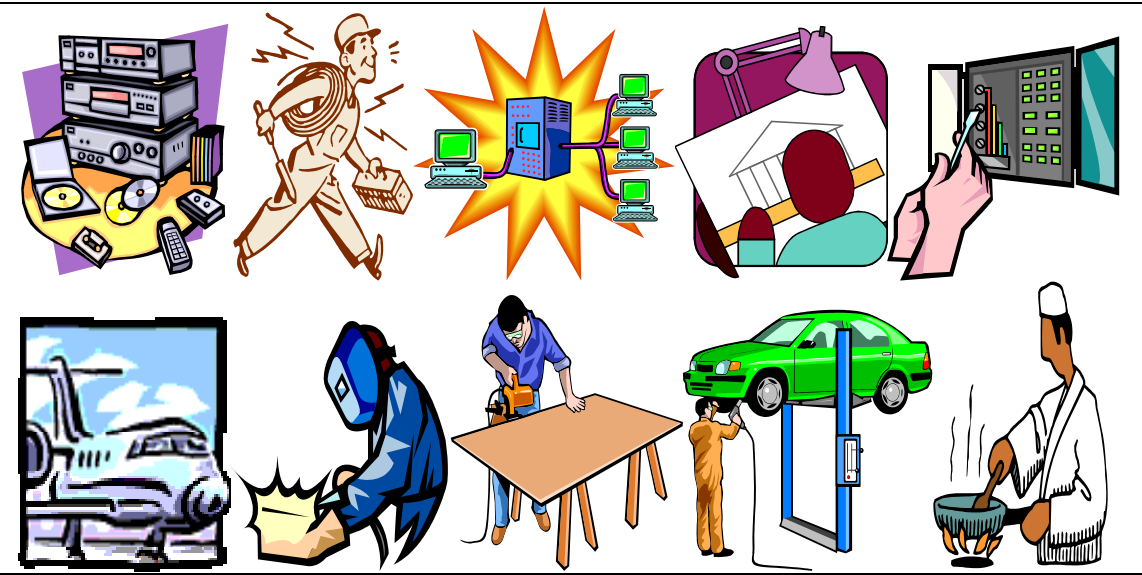

Vocational Education and Training

VET at Corio Bay Senior College

Vocational Education and Training (VET) is a national system designed to skill workers to work in particular industries eg plumbing, retail. Engineering etc. VET prepares students for their future working lives.

Students may include a VET certificate in their VCE program or complete a VET in the VCAL program and undertake training in a specific vocational area. VET courses skill students in specific industry areas that directly relate to the requirements of that work place. Students complete on-the-job and off-the-job training during their VET certificate. VET adds value to each student's options for employment. Students receive a Nationally Accredited Industry-Based Certificate at II or III level and a Statement of Attainment with all industry modules listed.

VET in the VCE at Corio Bay

You can choose a VET in the VCE program as part of your studies at Corio Bay. This offers you a vocational certificate with VCE credit built in.

This means that you will get training in a specific vocational area, for instance hospitality, information technology, horticulture or aero skills. This training will contribute towards satisfactory completion of your VCE, may contribute towards your VCE score (ENTER) and it will give you a nationally recognised vocational qualification. This will provide you with access to further training, and improve your chances of getting work or an apprenticeship when you leave the college.

Choosing 'VET in the VCE' at Corio Bay:

- You will need to obtain a 'Corio Bay Program Selection Form'
- Choose the VET certificate that best suits you. This takes the place of one (1) VCE subject
- Choose 4 VCE subjects of which one (1) must be English
- Fill out the form with assistance from your college career counsellor, your advocate, home group teacher, parent/s, other adult
- Submit the form to –
Corio Bay Administration Office marked "attention AP"
Your home school if it is Norlane or Flinders Peak

- You may want to have your VCE subjects "matching" your VET certificate or you may choose "non-matching" VCE subjects
- It is recommended that students read the relevant VET brochure for information about VCE subjects before choosing subjects

VET in the VCAL at Corio Bay

A VET certificate is compulsory in an Intermediate VCAL program at Corio Bay. If you choose to study the Victorian Certificate of Applied Learning (VCAL) at Corio Bay then you will take part in a VET certificate.

What is VET in the VCAL?

VET in the VCAL is where an individual student wants a direct pathway into employment in a particular industry and chooses the relevant VET certificate that is offered at Corio Bay and completes this within the four compulsory strands of the VCAL. Eg: Student wants employment in the computer industry and chooses the VET Certificate III Information.

At Corio Bay there are 2 'Themed VET in the VCAL' programs and any VET certificate offered as 'VET in the VCAL':

- Building VCAL – Intermediate (Themed VCAL)
- Moto VCAL (Automotive and Engineering) - Intermediate (Themed VCAL)
- VET in the VCAL – choose the VET certificate that suits you

Choosing a 'VET in the VCAL' at Corio Bay:

It is necessary that you read the Senior College 'VCAL Information Booklet' before choosing a VET in the VCAL program.

- You will need to obtain a 'Corio Bay Program Selection Form'
- Choose the VCAL program that best suits you. 'Building VCAL' or 'Moto VCAL' or any 'VET in the VCAL'
- Fill out the form with assistance from your college career counsellor, your advocate, home group teacher, parent/s, other adult
- Submit the form to –
